

### The world of mini beasts

Tuesday is bursting with spring exploration as we dive into the world of mini beasts. Children begin the day with a Mini Beast Tuff Tray, filled with pretend insects, bark, soil, twigs and natural textures to spark curiosity and imaginative play. They can also create their own paper plate bumble bees, adding paint, wings and stripes. ### DROP OFF & COLLECTION

We offer a diverse range of activities to cater to all interests and your child will have the freedom to select which activities they wish to participate in.
