Mini Pirates, Treasure & Forest Explorers

Discover a day of fun, learning, and adventure at Junior Holiday Club!

We kick off the week with a morning full of hands-on adventures! Children can create their own pirate passports, play pirate snap, and explore play dough fun. The tuff tray is packed with sand, treasure, boats, pearls, and rocks, and creative challenges include “Pin the Patch” and tea-bag printed treasure maps. After lunch, it’s time to get moving with bikes and scooters, followed by small-group treasure hunts in the forest – perfect for teamwork and problem-solving. In the afternoon, children can bake treasure cookies, craft swords with junk modelling, and make telescopes. The day ends with more outdoor fun, including bikes, scooters, mud kitchen, water and sand activities, and sports games, letting children burn off energy and enjoy time with friends.

Wednesday 27 May

Pirate Disco & Creative Challenges

Day two starts with a lively disco morning, full of musical games and prizes. Children can take on the “Walk the Plank” and balloon cannon challenges, testing their balance and agility in a fun, active way. Creative stations allow children to make eye patches and salt dough gold coins, exploring their imagination and fine motor skills. After lunch, bikes and scooters are back outdoors before an afternoon of live entertainment, bringing stories and performances to life. The day finishes with a pirate-themed picnic – complete with seaweed wraps, parrot food pots, cannonball snacks, and “Berry’d Treasure” pudding. Later, children enjoy a mix of outdoor activities, sports, and sensory play, keeping the afternoon lively and fun.

Day three is packed with collaborative challenges and hands-on crafts. Mornings feature egg carton treasure chests, pirate hats, paper plate parrots, jewellery making, and painting at the art station. After lunch, children head outdoors for bikes, scooters, and water play with small boats and aqua beads. The highlight of the afternoon is a team-building challenge, constructing a large cardboard pirate boat together, encouraging teamwork, problem-solving, and creativity. After dinner, children continue to enjoy outdoor play, mud kitchen, water and sand activities, and a range of sports, making the most of the space and their time with friends.



Friday 29 May

Park Adventures & Movie Magic

We end the week with a mix of exploration, creativity, and relaxation. The morning begins with small-group adventures at Oaken Grove, then hands-on crafts including bottle treasure creations, water-based tattoos, ship flag design, and wanted posters. After lunch, children can enjoy bikes and scooters, followed by pirate hook crafts using cups. The afternoon includes a relaxing in-house movie with popcorn, while outdoor play continues with bikes, scooters, mud kitchen, water and sand activities, and sports games, giving everyone the chance to enjoy their favourite activities one last time and celebrate a fantastic week.

The afternoon continues with a visit to the Windsor & Royal Borough Museum, followed by time to relax and play at Clewer Memorial Recreation Ground. We'll also take a stroll past St John's Parish Church before heading to the riverside to feed the ducks. The day finishes with dinner at McDonald's before returning, rounding off a full and memorable first day.



Wednesday 27 May

Team work makes the dream work

Day two is all about the outdoors, teamwork, and hands-on fun. Based on the field, children will work together to build their own camp areas, including tents and cosy spaces to relax in. Throughout the morning, they'll take part in a range of team games such as tug of war, football, and group challenges, building confidence and cooperation along the way. Marshmallows will also be toasted for a classic camp-style treat. At lunchtime, children will prepare their own food, making chicken kebab skewers and hotdogs using instant BBQ trays, with staff supervision. They'll also have the opportunity to chop their own vegetables, encouraging independence and practical skills. GET READY FOR ACTION?

Our Wise Owls Clubs are all about making life easier for parents and exciting for children!

Our club is a fun & familiar home away from home - without the tech! Our dedicated staff are compassionate carers to all the children in our care; fostering a supportive and inclusive atmosphere where children are free to be themselves.

We offer a safe space to play, explore and grow. A place where children laugh out loud every day. We have a wide variety of thoughtfully planned activities tailored to excite, challenge and motivate children aged 3 to 14 and to suit all interests.

Our approach is child-led, so while we will provide encouragement, we respect each child's choices and support them in the activities they choose to participate in. We are passionate about promoting well-being and believe every child should enjoy play and physical activity outdoors every day.

DROP OFF & COLLECTION

The fun begins at 8:30am and ends at 5:30pm. Upon arrival, children will be grouped by age and will have some free playtime at the start of the day to explore the array of activities on offer. Once all the children have arrived, we will get to know each other, explain the programme for the day, and discuss housekeeping matters. If you plan to pick your child up early, please let staff know in advance as we may be at the local park! Kindly make sure to pick up your child before the club closes.

WHAT TO WEAR / WHAT TO BRING

Come dressed ready for action and be comfortable! At Wise Owls, we love to spend time outdoors, so during the colder months, please make sure you wear something warm and bring a coat and woolly hat (clearly labelled). Wear suitable footwear for running around, climbing over play equipment, walking (in particular for outings) and in winter, getting muddy. In spring and summer, please ensure you have a hat. We often get messy, so a change of clothes is always a good idea! Please bring a labelled water bottle every day.

MEALS & NUTRITION

You can pre-order a daily meal at the point of booking or your child can bring a packed meal. Pre-ordered meals will consist of a healthy morning snack, and a two-course meal served for lunch at 12pm and for tea at 4pm. At least one hot meal is provided each day, often two depending on the daily programme. We aim to provide children with a healthy, balanced diet. If your child is bringing a packed lunch, please provide enough food to keep them well nourished for a long & active day (including a morning snack, lunch and tea) *We operate a nut free environment, so please do not bring any products containing nuts.

WHAT ACTIVITIES WILL YOUR CHILD DO AT CLUB?

Our approach to activities is child-led so children have the choice which activities they want to take part in during the course of the day (with the exception of outings). We offer a diverse range of activities to cater to all interests and your child will have the freedom to select which activities they wish to participate in. While we will provide encouragement, we respect their choices and won't force them to engage in activities they are not keen on.

KEEPING YOUR CHILD SAFE

Our team comprises of many skilled and experienced childcare professionals. All team members have undergone DBS checks, while our first aiders have received paediatric first aid training. We always maintain regulation staff-to-child ratios to guarantee appropriate supervision of your child. When we leave base camp to discover new and exciting activities, we increase our staff-to-child ratios and risk assess all excursions.

Our club is a technology free zone! Yay! Believe it or not, the children LOVE IT! Please do not send your child to club with an electronic device. If you do, it will be kept in their bag and we cannot guarantee the security of the device.
